## CURRENT GUIDANCE REMAINS THE SAME

**“The Road Forward”** provides guidance from both the NJDOE and NJDOH in order to provide full-day, full-time, in-person instruction and operations for the 2021-2022 school year. In “The Road Forward” the term, “practicable” is used often to refer to when something can be implemented and when it may not be able to be. The strict rule that must be followed is that we must operate on our traditional full day schedule, for all students in-person only. As a result of this directive, much of what we were able to implement last year when we had a small percentage of students in-person will not be able to be implemented when we have 100% of our students.
